These tickets are a fantastic savings over the regular general admission price. Combine your AMC tickets with **AMC scrip** from Mrs. Barrett in the school office to purchase sodas and snacks.

Buying them is simple:

- 1) Return the **order form with payment** (cash or check) to the school office, by **Thursday February 11th**.
- 2) Ticket pick up: **Tuesday February 16th & Thursday February 18th, 8:15 am - 8:45 am & 2:15 - 2:45** in front of the MPR. As the tickets are not replaceable if lost or stolen, it is preferable if parents pick up the tickets in person. (If you are going to have your child pick up the tickets, please send a note with them giving us your permission to release the tickets.)
- 3) Take them to the theatre's box office and exchange them for your movie's tickets.
